State:

<u>2-1-1 Maryland</u>: The 2-1-1 database has information on nearly 5,000 agencies and programs across the state. Each week 2-1-1 Maryland handles thousands of calls from people in need, providing referrals to services and helping people problem-solve when the services they need are not available.

Maryland Department of Human Services Office of Home Energy Programs: Energy Assistance is a year round program. You can apply at any time during the year, but you can only receive benefits once each year and must reapply each fiscal year (July- June).

BGE Assistance: BGE offers a host of empowering programs, services and incentives to help you conserve energy, save money and protect the environment.
